YMCA BC Child Care Resource & Referral (CCRR)

- One of 38 local provincially funded Child Care Resource & Referral programs who provide CCRR services in 70+ locations throughout the province
- Funded by the Ministry of Education and Child Care and administered by YBC
- Office locations in Prince George and Vanderhoof, and serves the communities of Fort Fraser, Fort St. James, Fraser Lake, Mackenzie, McBride, Prince George, Valemount, and Vanderhoof
- Operates three family resource programs: Highland Child Development Centre, Prince George Family Y, and Integris Community Centre

Child Care Resource and Referral (CCRRs) programs enhance the availability and accessibility of a range of child care options and services and build relationships within the child care sector to support the advancement of the [ChildCareBC](#) Plan.

The Ministry of Education and Child Care provides funding to CCRR service providers, which work with the Province to improve access to affordable, quality and inclusive child care in all B.C. communities.

The YMCA BC CCRR has lending libraries in our Prince George and Vanderhoof offices. Our lending libraries contain items which are included in the following categories:

➤ Enhanced Child Care Referrals

The CCRR maintains a database of licensed child care facilities for the communities we serve. The CCRR reviews each parent's request using our database of child care programs to help determine special requests and care needs, hours of operation, ages of children, location, and school's serviced. The CCRR will then provide parents with information (both written and/or verbal) on child care to help inform them of their child care options. The CCRR will provide referrals that most closely match the family's request, including those with vacancies.

Child care workforce can provide CCRR staff with additional information regarding their facilities such as:

- Programming information
- Qualifications of care provider(s)
- Hours of operation
- Languages spoken
- Schools served, etc.

This information is of great interest to parents who are searching for child care and it is to your advantage to provide these details. There may be times when you will need to make changes to your profile. ➤ Access to Provider Drop-In Opportunities

CCRR staff periodically offer drop-in opportunities for child care workforce. These drop-in events are rotated throughout the communities we serve and vary in content. Past drop-in opportunities have included:

- Circle and Story Times
- Stories, Puppets & Songs led by Children Librarians
- Active Play, Friday Playtime and Little Explorer's Playgroup drop-in programs

➤ Community Referral Access

➤ Laminating & Photocopying

CCRR program users can access an extra-wide laminator for poster-size materials by calling ahead. Photocopying is available at both locations, but only black & white printing is offered due to high color printing costs.

Photocopy Rate: \$0.25 per printed page
